How Variety BC School Grants work:

Schools and Districts applying for a Variety Schools grant must submit a quote for their project to Variety BC for consideration and will reach out to their chosen vendor directly to secure this for their application.

Once a grant application is approved, the school will begin fundraising to reach 50% of the total cost of their project and submit its funds raised to Variety BC who then matches their fundraising efforts. A single purchase order is issued to the vendor by Variety BC using the combined funds, with invoices due to Variety BC.
