

When Jonathan was a newborn. Variety was able to supply his family with a specialized - and expensive - baby formula for an entire month after one of his surgeries. This alone helped his family through a very difficult time.



Upon entering elementary school, Variety made it possible for Jonathan to receive ongoing tutoring at the Down Syndrome Resource Foundation. This crucial support has been instrumental in the seventh grader's academic success & it has also taught Jonathan life skills that will help him become more independent as he reaches adolescence.



Last year, Variety supported Jonathan with a private psychoeducational assessment. This assessment provided school administrators along with his teacher and his parents with the tools to best support his learning as an individual education plan (IEP) was developed. Thanks to you, Jonathan now learns in a way that works for him!
